We're making a different kind of delay here, folks! If you're reading this, you must be getting ready to party like it's 1983. We've kept your original, dry signal path analog and pure, then given you a 21db overdrive preamp to smash a lo-fi digital delay chip designed for karaoke machines and kids' toys into smeared, repeated glory. Yeah, we're going back in time – back to when they measured data in KILOBYTES!



ATTACK controls the gain and force of the repeater preamp. Keep it low to keep things cleaner, or crank it for louder, dirtier repeats. Your original signal is not affected by this control, only the repeats.



The BINARY CLOCK controls the delay time, and can take the PT2399 chip past 500ms. You may notice that higher delay times can result in more noise. This is natural for this chip and part of its charm.



SUMMATION controls the feedback and number of repeats. Turning this up higher can create near-infinite repeats, while maxing the control can cause the effect to "runaway".



LEVEL controls the overall volume level of the repeats relative to your original, uneffected signal. Consider this a 'post' control along with the 'pre' ATTACK control, and balance them to your preference.



HAVOC introduces a filtered "runaway" option – instead of diming the SUMMATION control, you can hold this switch down for a focused override of that control, and release it to return to your settings.

On the inside of your pedal is a small trimpot marked TACOS. This is not a misprint. TACOS is our term for a control that allows a subtle degree of pitch shifting in the repeats. While we've preset this amount, you may \*gently\* insert a Phillips head screwdriver into the trimpot and turn it should you wish to customize your preferred degree of this effect.
